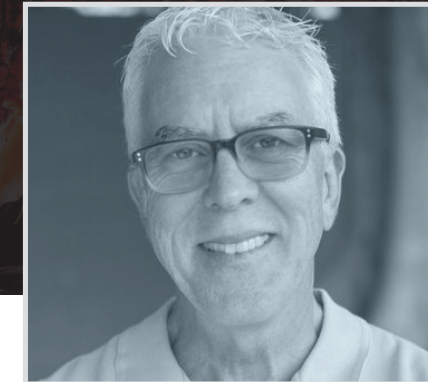
DAVE VERHAAGEN, PhD, ABPP

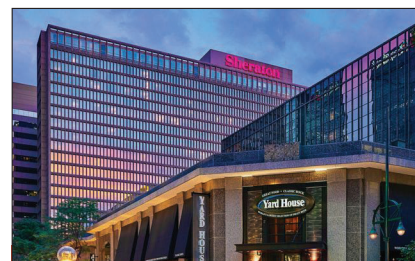
REID WILSON, PhD
